### PLEASE READ THESE NOTES CAREFULLY

Members are required to play on **all 4 days**.

**RDGC Golf Carts** – R 220. Carts are available and priority will be given to those players who need a cart for **medical reasons** for all 4 days – and a medical certificate is required.

Privately owned carts will be charged a trail fee of R40 per round.

There is a limited amount of space for storage and charging facilities available at the courses, so please advise your Secretary if these facilities are required.

**DCC Golf Carts** – R 220. Carts are available and priority will be given to those players who need a cart for **medical reasons** for all 4 days – and a medical certificate is required.

**Privately owned carts are not allowed at DCC.**

**Caddie fees** will be R 180 plus tip per round at both courses.

Players needing similar tee off times in order to travel together – please inform the Secretary of your Society when you send in your application. The Draw will endeavour to accommodate your request (**maximum group size of 4**) but this may not be possible on Thursday and Friday, due to varied handicaps in the Championships.

Seniors and their ladies are strongly encouraged to attend both the opening Cocktail Party and the closing Gala Dinner.

The formal dress requirement for the Gala Dinner is a dark suit or blazer, dark pants and Senior's tie or bow tie.

**Please sign the Entry Application at the bottom of page 5 – it will not be accepted unless signed.**

Should there be changes to the information you have put on your entry application please inform your **Society Secretary**.

This is important for the Draw if your handicap moves into or out of the Championship division.

The Ladies programme is subject to change depending on demand for the various events. Changes will be shown in the Tournament Brochure, to be distributed in March. All tours, for which transport is provided, depart from the Royal Durban Golf Club. Where own transport is required, the KZN ladies will endeavour to accommodate, and maps to venues will be provided in the welcome bag. If you require accommodation in the Durban area, please ask your Secretary for details of B&Bs, guest houses and hotels that have already been sent by the KZN Society to all Secretaries.
